BRADFORD FIRST AT CFC's SWO

Joseph Mark Bradford, whose extraordinary results in recent national events (including clear 1st at the '78 U. S. Open), continued his string of successes by adding "the 1978 Southwest Open Champion" to his list of titles. Drawing two of his seven games (one with John Peters and the other with NY master Henry Gonzalez), Bradford stood with five others at the summit of the 258 player field. The tiebreaking system handed the second place trophy to national star John Peters (representing Church's Fried Chicken, Inc. and ranking highest among the entries) whose other draw was with the honored Texan, Master Ken Smith. Third place went to Wisconsinian William Martz, a master with experience in the international arena, who drew Expert Bill Orton and Gonzalez. The remaining three who tied for first were Master John Hall (who lost to Orton), Dennis Gogel (named "1st Expert", having but one loss - to Bradford) and Jess Goodman ("1st 'A'", losing to Smith). Each of these six received a \$567 cash prize.

Nine players finished with scores of $5\frac{1}{2}$ - $1\frac{1}{2}$. Robert Brieger, Michael Condon and Larry Englebretson shared the rest of the Experts' monies (\$300) while Ken Smith, Tony Alston, Larry Brandt, Tony Campbell, Enrique Gomez and William Rogosin divided the 5th overall and remaining 'A' prizes between them, making \$75 apiece.

Class B prizes were taken by four 5-2 scores. Roger Johnson took the trophy and shared \$700 with Scott Elliot, Samuel Naylor and Vince Parsons.

Class C also fell to a 5-2 scorer, the \$300 and trophy landing in Stephen Jackson's lap. The rest of the 'C' money went to David Carr and Robert Fuller, who earned \$100 each.

Class D&Es' trophy and \$300 cash prize were also won outright, an outstanding performance by Michael Calogridis ($4\frac{1}{2}$ - $2\frac{1}{2}$). Donald Flournoy cinched 2nd (\$125) with a last round win that gave him a final score of $3\frac{1}{2}$ - $3\frac{1}{2}$. The remaining \$75 in this class was divided thirteen ways! William Anderson, Johnny Arnold, James Baker, William Gibson, Jeff Grimes, Roger Henderson, Don Howard, Lewis Johns, Tony Martinez, Steve Means, Robert Phares, Phil Plata and E. Lee Van Der Wal each received \$6 by scoring 3-4.

Alfred Ghadimi won the Unrated trophy and \$100 cash prize with a 4-3 score, while Henry Orosco picked up the second prize (\$50) by a $3\frac{1}{2}$.

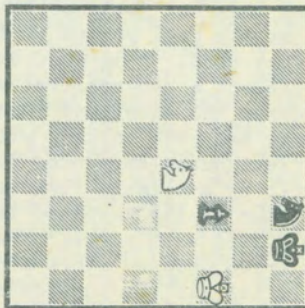
