Congratulations to GM-elect Davorin Kuljasevic! Texas Tech's top gun got his final GM norm at the huge (287-player) Pula Open, held June 19-26 in Croatia. He cinched the needed last round draw to finish 7-2 in an eight-way tie for fourth. Tied for first with 7.5 were GMs Robert Zelcic, Ognjen Jovanic and Sinisa Drazic. Ex-champion Boris Spassky was the guest of honor.

GM Gareev wins National Open

GM Timur Gareev won the National Open (Las Vegas, June 10-13) with an exciting last round win over GM Varuzhan Akobian, who went in with a perfect 5-0. Gareev finished in clear first with 5.5/6 for \$6,000. He was the first clear winner in a National Open since 1989!

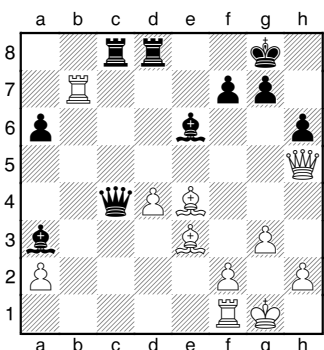

Coming in a tie for second place and earning just over \$1500 were: GMs Varuzhan Akobian, **Alejandro Ramirez**, Artur Kogan and Aleksandr Lenderman. IM Irina Krush earned the Under 2500 prize clear, good for \$1603, while there was a huge tie for the Under 2400/Under 2300 prize between Sabina Foisor, Tatev Abrahamyan, **Michael Langer**, Edward Formanek, Edison Ruge and Joshua Gutman.

NTD **Bill Snead** of Amarillo directed a combined field of 693 players. "We had players from over twenty countries represented, from Mongolia to Mexico," he noted.

GM Izoria is Texas state champion

GM Zviad Izoria, 26, from the Republic of Georgia, went 6-1 to win the Texas State Championship (Dallas, May 28-31). Now a Texas resident, he received the C. Harold Bone memorial trophy and \$750. Rated 300 points above the field, he won in a walk with draws to Deepyaman Datta (first Expert, \$525) and Alex Chua (clear second place with 5, \$375). Five players tied with 4.5 (see below). Prizes were the 75% baseline. **Crosstable: p. 26.**

The weakness of computer chess analysis, such as it is, comes from the horizon effect. After analyzing so many billions of positions and rendering a verdict, the computer cannot see further than its end of analysis horizon.

For us humans our horizon is closer, but we do have a sense of the frigid lands beyond – a sense that we can act upon. For the computer there is no sense to it. There are three types of positions that lend themselves to such long, computer unfriendly horizons. The most common and understood are closed positions. The others are the transition from middlegame to endgame; and the least likely, trapped pieces whose capture is beyond some of the horizon analysis. What I like is that this game has the last two. For the next several moves the trapped bishop may be influencing Fritz.

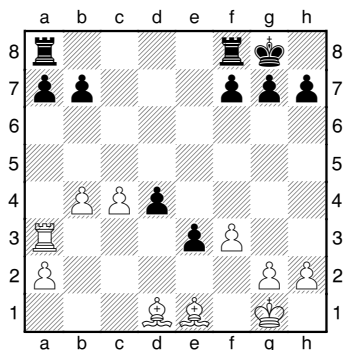
